EYFS phonics and writing is really coming along! I love seeing their sentence/caption writing from pictures in the mornings. Good work EYFS!

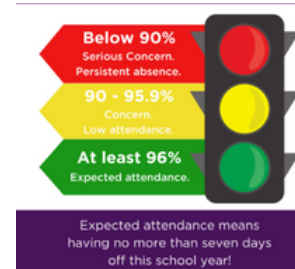
