Sports Clubs and PE have been running really well with Mr Russell with the children really enjoying their time with him.

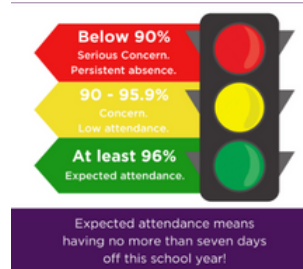

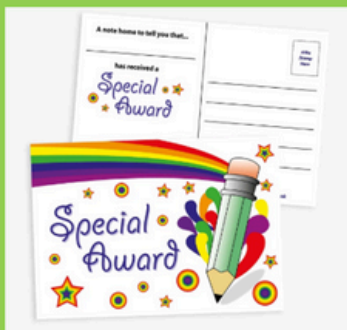
READING AND WRITING AT CHERRY TREET
