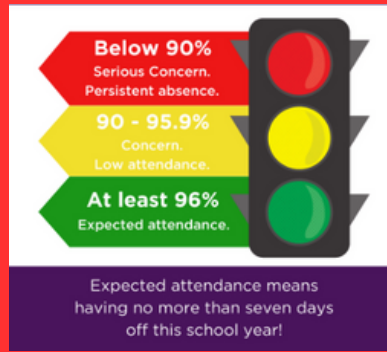
Dates and Events
