Thank you to all the parents that attended the workshop after school. Please follow the link below for some great family activities and support to build positive relationships and help your child to be confident learners.

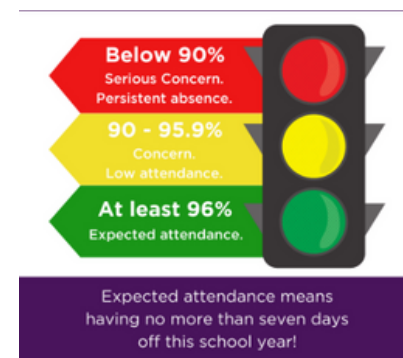

WHEN FINISHED, YOUR CHILD TAKES A SHORT QUIZ ON THE COMPUTER - PASSING THE QUIZ IS AN INDICATION THAT YOUR CHILD HAS UNDERSTOOD WHAT HAS BEEN READ.
